

At the moment, we have two movable operational Speed Indicator devices in Hanslope and 1 ANPR camera. The latter is run and monitored by Thames Valley Police. The SIDS as they are known are sited at various locations round the village. The printout they produce gives details of speed, number of vehicles travelling and times of traffic flow throughout a 24 hour period. The three noticeable hotspots within the village boundary, are 1) Hartwell Road 2 Park Road and 3 Forest Road from Tathall Oak Driveway towards the road leading to Salcey Forest. The permanent SID recently purchased by the Parish Council and sited in Forest Road has had the software update installed this morning by the "Traffic Technology" engineer. The correct windows should be on display. I am aware that another device called Sentinel can be purchased by the Parish Council. This can be used by volunteers who have passed an online course. If anyone is interested, please contact the Parish Council.

The speed humps in Forest Road were initially too high. MKC have now made sure they are ~~not~~ of the correct height. They were installed by Bloor Homes. The humps in Castlethorpe Road near Mayfield Homes were installed by the developer. The ensuing ^{ongoing} ~~water~~ flooding problems were reported by me to both MKC Highways and Anglian Water just after Christmas 2022. Nothing has been done since.

Because the three large developments all went through an appeal, we villagers have no say in the traffic calming measures which have been installed. Our village white gates are now ^{in place} installed.

Here are yesterday's results from the SID in Park Road near the Norse Pond. Traffic coming into the village.

11 day period

12,000 vehicles coming into and through the main village street.

6,000 cars doing over the 30 mph speed limit
