No signing up fee its FREE, you can pick what information you would like to receive, and any information we send out you can share, by forwarding to Facebook, Whats app etc. You can reply direct to the administrator following an appeal for either witness or CCTV footage. Signing up is quick and easy, and do not forget to tick the box for ring doorbell or CCTV as this helps us when appeals for CCTV are made. Sign up here – www.thamesvalleyalert.co.uk

Sign up to Neighbourhood Watch (NHW) We are very fortunate in Milton Keynes to have the Milton Keynes Neighbourhood Watch Association who can help you set up a scheme in your area. (1) Check to see if a scheme is running already by logging onto www.ourwatch.org.uk and enter your postcode, it will tell you if there is scheme and you can ask to join. (2) NO SCHEME but want to set one up, contact your local Neighbourhood Police team via 101 or look at the MK Neighbourhood Watch Association and their website is.mknhwa.org.uk.
