There was no formal agenda as the meeting focused on community consultation with a proposed leaflet to be delivered to every house in the parish and two meetings for residents to attend to ask questions and give their views on the revision work on the made Neighbourhood Plan.

- JW had prepared a leaflet outlining how residents could get involved with the Parish Council and make their views heard. This was discussed at length and changes made to include a brief explanation of what a Neighbourhood Plan was, why it was being revised and to invite all residents to the meetings. The agreed leaflet will need to have 2000 A4 folded to A5 copies printed plus a couple of A2 posters and the PC have already approved spending on this. The Steering Group would prefer a local printer and AA/JW will arrange printing, if possible, to be ready before 20 October. AA will work with the SG and village contacts to deliver the leaflets to every house over the weekend of the 21/22 October to give enough notice of the meetings.
- Two residents' meetings are planned to be held in the Community Hall on Sunday 29 October from 15:00 to 19:00 and on Monday 30 October from 19:00 to 21:00. SG will need access half-an-hour before the start to set up a long table and chairs theatre style and to put up explanatory posters on the notice boards. There will also be paper and pencils for residents to make suggestions and a box for these to be collected; these will be analysed at the following Steering Group meeting. Meetings will have a brief introduction and then some SG members will be around to answer any questions.
