- Update from the Parish Council meeting on retaining Neil Homer and JC as consultants. DC went through the section of the Parish Council meeting minutes relating to the review and confirmed that O'Neil Homer Consulting and JC would be used as consultants on this review of the Neighbourhood Plan.
- The terms of reference as amended by Gill Merry, the Parish Clerk, for this Steering Group to conduct the review were discussed and were agreed with the proviso that Steering Group meetings will be closed to the public but the agendas, minutes and updates on each meeting will be available to the public by being published on the Parish Council website and posted on the village notice board.
- The 'Hanslope Survey Your Village Your voice' prepared by AA was discussed and some amendments suggested and JC will put these together for further discussion and agreement by those members unable to attend this meeting.
- After discussion on the options for this review either a mini review now and a full review when Milton Keynes Council complete their current review of Plan:MK expected to be 2025 or a full review now; the group decided to recommend a full review now as it was felt important to extend the development boundary to include Tathall End and this changes the nature of the Plan.
