18.182	Apologies for Absence Apologies were received from Councillors Wheeler, Proctor and Simpkins.	
18.183	Declarations of Interest There were no declarations of interest on any item on the agenda.	
18.184	Approval of Minutes The minutes of the meeting on 9 April together with the amendments circulated were approved and signed as a true record. The minutes of the meeting on 12 November were approved and signed as a true record.	
18.185	Matters Arising from Previous Meeting Councillor Courtman raised item 18.180 on behalf of Councillor Simpkins and noted that the parish council is still chasing the matter of the trees at no. 72 Weston Drive. Councillor Price confirmed with regard to item 18.174 that the payment to J Ullah for pavilion security has been paid.	
18.186	Representations from Members of the Public There were no members of the public in attendance.	
18.187	Current Planning Matters The Chair thanked the Parish Councillors for their attendance at the December Development Control Committee meeting. The Eventing Centre application was deferred to allow time for late reports to be read and factored into the decision. MKC are commissioning their own cumulative effect report for this application. The application for the rear of The Globe was refused. The idea of a planning section on the Parish Council website was raised. This will be on the January agenda.	TW

18.189	Recreation Ground Redevelopment Councillor R Green reported that work to resolve construction issues will be taking place soon. Extra lighting has been installed. A post box is to be fitted before Christmas. Work is underway on procuring and fitting new signage.	
18.190	Future Open Spaces No update. To be removed from future agendas.	
18.191	Newsletter Options The November issue has been printed and distributed by councillors. A suggestion was made that door-to-door delivery could be replaced	

	with pick-up locations where a number of copies would be left. It was agreed to maintain the current issue schedule and deliver to four pick-up points in public locations around the village, starting with the March issue.	
18.192	Allotments It was noted that renewal letters will be issued towards the end of January. The Allotment Holders' AGM will be on 28 January. The allotment land has been registered with the Land Registry.	
18.193	Neighbourhood Development Plan Update The plan was submitted for inspection on Friday 30 November. The decision, agreed by email between councillors, to commission O'Neill Homer to finalise the pre-submission plan and submit it, was ratified.	
18.194	Village Maintenance Issues The issue of a damaged road sign was discussed, to be brought back to the January meeting. Councillor Courtman to provide information to the Clerk concerning the damaged public bench.	TW DC
